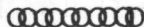
The following is a Key to abbreviations used in the Who's Who:

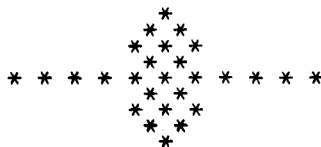
