In the second-hand collector's market, these rare volumes can cost from £25 to £50 each—and more. Now, through this new publishing division, the 'not so early birds' can fill in the gaps in their collections—at last. Because the printing must perform to be a very small one, the unit cost must be proportionately higher. But we have succeeded in pegging it at £15 per copy in most cases.
